at the junction of Union Square and the Financial District in San Francisco, with immediate access to the Montgomery Street Bart station. The 40,144 SF building features four ground floor retail spaces, a top performing salon on the second floor and three floors of office space above. The largest retail space on the ground floor is a 6,883 SF second generation restaurant with a large open floor plan, high ceilings, and arch windows. The floor plan also features additional square footage on the mezzanine level that can be easily utilized as a back of house office.




